



Privacy Notice

This privacy notice discloses the privacy practices for the Robotics Institute of Maine (RIM), including but not limited to its website, newsletter, and other data collection processes. This privacy notice applies to all information collected by the organization by any means included herein.

Please be aware of the following:

RIM will only collect the information provided, and no other.

RIM will not share that information with anyone, unless required to do so by a court or other appropriately authorized government agency, and only upon presentation of a bona fide demand, and after notifying you of the request.

You can correct any inaccuracies in the information at any time by contacting info@rimaine.org with the revised information contained therein and asking for the data to be corrected.

Information Collection, Use, and Sharing

RIM is the sole owner of the information collected by this organization, except that information that is shared through our partner GiveButter. RIM only has access to/collect information that you voluntarily give us via email or other direct contact from you.

RIM will not sell or rent this information to anyone.

RIM will use your information to respond to you, regarding the reason you contacted us.

Notwithstanding a legal request for information as outlined above, RIM will not share your information with an unaffiliated third party, other than as necessary to fulfill a specific request made by you.

Unless you ask us not to, RIM may contact you via email in the future to tell you about changes to this privacy policy.

Your Access to and Control Over Information

You may opt out of any future contacts from RIM at any time. You can do the following by contacting us via the email address or phone number given on our website:

1. See what data RIM has about you, if any.
2. Change/correct any data RIM has about you.
3. Have RIM delete any data it has about you.
4. Express any concern you have about RIM's use of your data.

Security

RIM takes precautions to protect your information. When you submit information via the website, your information is protected both online and offline. While RIM uses encryption to protect sensitive information transmitted online, RIM also protects your information offline. Only individuals who need the information to perform a specific job (e.g. specific program coordinators) are granted access to personally identifiable information. The computers/servers in which RIM stores personally identifiable information are kept in a secure environment.
